

Minutes of meeting with George & Rosemary Cann

Date: 10th March 2016

Venue: Aylesbeare Village hall

Those present: George & Rosemary Cann, Ed Heynes (town & country planning consultant), Ken Chun (Parish Council Chair), Mark Fisher, Steve Greenslade and David Timms

- The meeting commenced at 6.30 pm, and was introduced by David Timms who explained the purpose of the meeting, which was to plan and confirm the details for the proposed Open Evenings on Tuesday 19th April and Monday 25th April, 4.00 to 8.00 pm.
- Ken Chun explained that he had no further information available regarding the application to develop the pub-site.
- The Cann's were invited, via their agent, to provide three sets of plans for the field behind the pub to include the village green, as identified from the Aims and Objectives, which would be displayed at the Open Evenings .
- A brief discussion took place on the Aims and Objectives, and both the Cann's and Ed Heynes were made aware that they were readily available from the Parish Council web-site under Neighbourhood Planning. Ed Heynes was also given a copy.
- The members of the steering group pointed out to all present that the Open Evenings must be community led.
- After much discussion it was felt that it would be good to have Ed Heynes present at the Open Evenings to answer questions from Parishioners if required.
- It was also agreed that the steering group members would not have any access to the proposed three sets of plans until the first of the Open Evenings.
- A comment form will be available on each evening inviting Parishioners to pass comments and express their views on the proposed plans. A secure box will be provided to enable people to complete the forms in a confidential and anonymous manner
